SkiStar's minimum snow guarantee, applicable to all Scandinavian resorts.

- Sälen: 15 pistes are open simultaneously in Lindvallen, in the high mountains, at Tandådalen and at Hundfjället. (10 for adults and 5 for children).
- Åre: 10 pistes are open simultaneously in Duved, Åre city and Björnen.
- Vemdalen: 8 pistes are open simultaneously in Björnrike, Vemdalskalet and Klövsjö/Storhogna.
- Hemsedal: 8 km prepared pistes and 628 vertical meters.
- Trysil: 20 km prepared pistes and 620 vertical meters.

If we are unable to fulfil the snow guarantee you'll have the opportunity to postpone or cancel your stay and get your money back till 11:00 on the day of your arrival. We will reimburse what you have paid for SkiPass, ski rental, ski school and accommodations, including the cancellation insurance.

The snow guarantee does not cover temporarily closed lifts or slopes, as a result of, for example, technical problems or bad weather. The snow guarantee only applies at our Scandinavian destinations, and not at St. Johann in Tirol.
