# Ski Scandinavia doubles the capacity of its winter charters to Scandinavian Mountains Airport in Sälen/Trysil

British charter operator Ski Scandinavia is doubling the capacity of its winter charters to Scandinavian Mountains Airport from 11 February 2023. It is operating direct flights from Gatwick to Sälen/Trysil ("the heart of skiing") on Saturdays. The venture builds on the positive experience gained last year, when the partnership was launched with a few trial flights.

# Five airlines and nine destinations to/from SMA

Five airlines are now offering flights to Scandinavian Mountains Airport this winter from Copenhagen, Groningen, Amsterdam, Lübeck, Ålborg, London, Stockholm-Bromma, Engelholm and Malmö.

Scandinavian Mountains Airport lies on the border between Sälen, the largest alpine ski area in Sweden, and Trysil, Norway's largest alpine ski resort. Short transfer times combined with a first-class family alpine skiing product give it a unique position on the market.
